# BEYOND THE MICROSCOPE - EXPLORING THE WORLD OF BIOTECHNOLOGY

On August 21, 2025, the Biotechnology Department of Institute of Science and Technology for Advanced Research (ISTAR), CVMUniversity, conducted a one-day hands-on workshop on "Techniques in Biotechnology" for Class 12<sup>th</sup> Biology of Anandalaya.

The workshop began with a brief presentation on the principles, processes, and applications of biotechnology. In the forenoon session, students practised bacterial isolation, sterilisation methods, and Gram staining in the Microbiology Lab. In the afternoon, they performed DNA isolation and gel electrophoresis in the Biotechnology Lab, with the resource person explaining the role of various reagents and buffers. Students also visited Sardar Patel Institute of Computer Science and Technology (SICART) to explore advanced scientific instruments.

The workshop provided experiential learning, helping students connect theory with practical applications and develop confidence in handling sophisticated apparatus and tools in microbiology labs.

#### **HEALTH AND WELL BEING**

### FIGHT THE BITE

An awareness programme on National Vector-Borne Diseases was conducted on July 10, 2025, by the District Health Department, Anand. The session was led by Dr. Rajesh Patel, EMO and in-charge DMO of the Health Department (Malaria Branch), District Panchayat Anand. Students from Classes 9<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> attended the programme, where Dr. Patel addressed key health concerns related to vector-borne diseases.

# **Objectives of the Programme:**

- To raise awareness about National Vector-Borne Diseases among students.
- To educate students on major health issues and effective methods for reducing the incidence of these diseases.
- To promote healthy lifestyle practices that can help prevent vector-related infections.
- To empower students to make informed decisions regarding their personal health and well-being.

The session provided valuable insights into prevention and emphasised the importance of maintaining hygienic surroundings to control vectors. The programme was highly informative and beneficial to all students, featuring live demonstrations of mosquito breeding, larvae, and larvivorous fish.

#### KNOW YOUR KITCHEN TRIO: SALT • SUGAR • OIL

During this academic session (2025–2026), the school displayed a **Sugar**, **Salt** and **Oil** board to create awareness on the consumption of these items and to promote healthier dietary choices. The CBSE suggested all its affiliated schools to have a Suger Board in the beginning of the current academic session. Anandalaya took a step further and decided to have Salt, Oil and Maida Board as well and spaced them before every PCTM round the year.

**Sugar Awareness Programme**: This programme focused on the hidden dangers of excessive sugar consumption, its effects on physical and mental health, and the importance of mindful eating. Interactive sessions led many participants to pledge to reduce their daily sugar intake.

**Salt Awareness Programme**: The programme addressed the role of salt in processed foods and its link to hypertension. Through demonstrations, participants learned about the hidden excess salt in regular meals and were encouraged to adopt balanced dietary habits.

**Oil Awareness Programme**: This programme covered different cooking oils, types of fats, and their nutritional profiles. Practical demonstrations helped students understand oil properties and how to choose healthier oils for everyday cooking.

These initiatives significantly enhanced both the students' and teachers' understanding of nutrition, empowering them to make informed, healthier eating choices.
